C. Michael Neuwelt, M.D. is a Clinical Professor of Medicine at the University of California, Chief of Rheumatology at The Alameda County Medical Center, and is also a physician at East Bay Rheumatology Medical Group. He is a member of the Physician Leadership council for the Lupus Research Institute in New York City and is on the advisory board of "Lupus Now" magazine of The Lupus Foundation of America in Washington, D.C. He has experience with an array of therapies which include Rituxan (rituximab) and Prasterone (DHEA). He is currently involved in lupus studies of biological agents including Ocrelizumab, Epratuzimab, Rontalizumab (anti-interferon-alpha monoclonal antibody) and pegulated humanized monoclonal antibody targeting CD40L. Dr. Neuwelt is involved in two upcoming trials in 2010, both with unique modulator activity: Lupuzor and Laquinimod. He has published numerous articles in various medical journals.

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
